- The call to order and welcome was completed by PAC President, Catherine Korda
- Resident Principal Yalil Nieves provided an overview of the NWEA MAP & BAS Testing
 - o A copy of today's PowerPoint presentation is available on Peterson's website
 - The Benchmark Assessment System (BAS) is a literacy test administered individually to each student by the classroom teacher three times per year. Reading comprehension questions on this test are administered depending on the fluency and accuracy during one-on-one reading. Throughout the test teachers record reading behaviors.
 - o Books are arranged by reading levels. A chart with reading levels was distributed to parents during today's meeting and parents were also able to see examples of books for each level.
 - The NWEA MAP test is a computerized assessment which measures skills in the areas of reading, math, science and language. This is a 52 item adaptive test, which means that the test is personalized to each student, with items based on the accuracy of each previous question. Test scores are compared with normative data and allows teachers and parents to assess yearly/term growth.
 - Parents were able to email PAC in advance to request a copy of their child's test scores at today's meeting or request them during the meeting. Peterson administrators were available to help with interpreting scores.
