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- A mid year hire will change the balance trajectory because of increasing spending to pay for the hired position.
 - One time budget adjustment to add ~9k to budget. Will retain to meet needs as it arises.
 - 24 k in available funds going forward.
 - Raised ~\$300 from winter concert.
 - Requesting a transfer of \$5,000 to cover additional subs for professional development.
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 - Enrollment: 799.
 - Attendance: 92.32%
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 - CIWP:
 - Community circles are continuing. SVC will reconvene in January. ~240 votes for student shirt contest. 95% completion for Cultivate survey.
 - Upcoming Pastries with the Principal: January 25, 9-9:45
 - Literacy Night will be rescheduled - will not happen end of January.
 - Balanced Assessment and Grading training during PD Day in December.
 - 5 week assessment cycles continue.
 - "What causes the big difference in proficiency scores?"
 - Reflection piece where teachers/admin identify trends and adjusting tier 1 instruction. Also creates a target group to focus on to drive intervention. Helps inform curricular spiraling/adjusting scope and sequence.
 - "Will there be calibration and reflection based on IAR performance with short-cycle assessments?"
 - As we get back STAR360, we can use that to calibrate across 5-week assessments, and used to determine who is likely to meet IAR growth goals. It can be hard to use IAR data in real time since data does not come back during the current academic year.
 - Weekly meetings for identify next steps.
 - ILT reviewing school wide data
 - Mini-observations walk-through tools
 - ACCESS test is currently being administered - will have a BAC report next month.
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 - Hiring:
 - Hired 6th grade DL teachers.
 - 5th grade teacher had to resign due to doctoral program requiring too much time which does not allow for full-time teaching.
 - 1 open TA position.
 - 1 SECA position - currently interviewing for position.
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 - Gym is painted! Seeking new lights for the gym.
 - Need a new quote for an ADA compliant door.
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- Bid went out for new intercom system.
 - Friends of Peterson - raised 8,614.
 - Feb 6 vaccine clinic.
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 - "Club information?"
 - Coming in either next Peterson Periodical or the following.
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 - "When will we have an update on projected enrollment/teacher position number?"
 - Have to wait for the district to give guidance. Looking at at least 2 cuts, which is probably the minimum.
 - Sent letter to staff about pre-k expansion, and who is likely to be impacted in terms of classrooms. Want to move quickly to help get Peterson onto the Pre-K application process.
 - District is unlikely to continually provide supplemental funds as they have been doing.
 - "It would be helpful to hear your thought process on the way that you organize your thoughts on the way you organize the school to meet student needs while considering budgetary constraints."
 - Helps to understand the endorsements that teachers have, and what kinds of services they can provide. Next year district is looking to make 2nd grade a benchmark year, which will affect personnel decisions.
 - Admin will share last year's budget presentation with LSC to help prep for the upcoming budget season. Will add to next agenda.
 - Continue to have community representative opening.
