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- PAC Report (Parent Advisory Council)- no report
 - BAC Report (Bilingual Advisory Committee)- included in the principals report
 - **Principal's Report**
 - 5 Essentials Data- want to highlight celebrations and name areas for growth
 - **Celebrations:**
 - Academic press (critical thinking)
 - Parent involvement, and safety.
 - **Areas for growth:**
 - Teacher to principal trust- teachers feel respected by the principal but need to grow their ability to trust.
 - instructional leadership
 - Quality PD- redistribution of schedule (in past schedule was designed to protect math instructional minutes)
 - **Next steps:** Focus on distributive leadership (hard to fill teacher positions on the various committees), feedback (PD and coffee and conversation). Principal will continue to make decisions that place children first.
 - **Constraints:** COVID, limited PD time, Nature of Change, difficult decisions (lit lab, etc)
 - **Question from Steven:** is there a correlation between a student's perception of learning and actual learning?
 - A→ Yes, it would seem like there is a correlation although there is some gap.
 - **Discussion on weight of questions on 5 essentials data.** Some areas that Peterson scored low in, the answers were typically agree and strongly agree so why did we score 9% in these areas?
 - School Wide Data
 - Classroom level goals
 - Growth- 5 week data cycle - correlation between scores on iReady and our own classroom assessments. February data showed a small dip in scores.
 - iReady- K-2 test → students took the test in August and then again in January.
 - Reading- 25% have already met growth for the year, 27% are on their way, and almost 50% are not making sufficient progress
 - Math- 24% met, 31% in progress, 45% not making sufficient progress
 - Instruction:
 - New intervention program called Amira- supported by reading interventionists. Will happen during small group instruction. Amira also has a screener for dyslexia.
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- Kindergarten switched to Foundations- Kinder
 - In the process of hiring a new TA for kindergarten
 - Partnerships:
 - Metro Chicago Mathematics initiative- helps K-5
 - Friends of Peterson Updates:
 - 10,000 dollars to Peterson for recess employee
 - Funding Wilson kits
 - First planning meeting for walk-a-thon will happen next week.
