


APPLYING TO HIGH SCHOOL



Program Types

Students are guaranteed a seat in the general education program of their neighborhood school and they **do not have to apply to attend**. If families are interested in their neighborhood school, we encourage them to include it on their application in their order of preference.

- Students are placed in line according to their total points
- 30% of available seats are filled by students with the highest scores.
- The remaining seats are filled by 25% of the highest scores in each tier.

CPS High School Admissions Exam Details

A single exam used for all HS programs, including Selective Enrollment, IB, CTE, Military, Fine & Performing Arts, and any other programs requiring test scores.

Note: No NWEA exams will be given or used for the application process this year.

Current CPS Students

Test Date: Nov. 9th, 2021

Students will test during the day at their current 8th grade school

Students will not need to register or schedule

Non- CPS Students

Test Dates:

- Saturday, Nov. 13, 2021
- Sunday, Nov. 14, 2021
- Saturday, Nov. 20, 2021
- Sunday, Nov. 21, 2021

Students will test at a designated CPS location

Students will schedule to test when they complete their GoCPS application online




Subscribe at go.cps.edu/contact
