Line-Up Procedures

Student Entrances and Exits (Every Day)

- Door #1 on the Plaza: Grades 1 and 2
- Door #3 on Kimball: PreK and Kindergarten
- Door #7 on Catalpa: Grades 3, 4 and 5
- •5th Graders ONLY leave through Door #6
- Door #10 on Christiana: Grades 6-8 enter every day at 8:35am.

Inclement Weather Line-Up:

- PreK, K: Hallway by Cafeteria
- 1, 2: Cafeteria
- 3rd: Main Hallway Lined up by Classroom
- 4th and 5th: 4th Grade Wing and Along Auditorium

Accompanying Students Into the Building

Parents of students in K, 1, and 2 will be allowed into the building until 8:50 on the first day only. Starting Wednesday, September 6, 2017, for safety reasons, K students must say goodbye to their children at the Kimball entrance, and 1st and 2nd students at the bottom of the plaza. If parents wish to stay with their child they should wait with him or her at the bottom of the plaza.

J at School FAQ

Where should I drop my child off for J at School in the morning? Please drop your child off at the cafeteria door on the plaza (door #2). Look for the "J at School Entrance" sign on the door.

What time does J at School begin? Our J at School program begins at 7:30 am and ends when school starts at 8:45 am.

Where should my child go at the end of the day? Children participating in J at School aftercare will report to the cafeteria as soon as they are dismissed from classes. Students in grades K-2 will be escorted by their teachers.

What time does J at School end? Our J at School program begins when school ends at 3:45 pm and ends at 6:00 pm.
