Budget 2018/2019 meeting & notes:

Income:

- Remove 4010 Individual Contributions Income because of inactivity.
- Remove 4030 Donations Freedom from Fundraising because of inactivity.
- Increased 5443 Dance A Thon to \$5,000 threshold anything above that goes to FOP.
- Added 5900 To capture the \$6,000 surplus from this year's budget.

Total Income budgeted: \$23,800, this is up from last year by \$6,845.

Expenses:

- Adjusted 8530 PTA National dues to reflect our expected income from dues of \$4.00/membership @ 100 members
- Increased 8590 PTA refreshments & Hospitality Meeting Food to reflect our usual expenditures of 200.00...up from 0.00 this year.
- Increased 8591 International Night Expenses from 1,000 to 1,250 to be in line with this years expenses.
- Decreased 8592 Unity Through the Arts from 1,500 to 1,250 to be in line with this years expenses.
- Increased 8597 Back to School Party from 650 to 1,000 to allow for a bullstering of food/entertainment at event.
- Removed 8600 Clubs and Misc Events 900 and replaced with specific accounts for the events we historically have supported as PTA.

- Increased 8621 Teacher Appreciation Week to 800, up from 600, to reflect historical spending.
- Added 8607 Art Dept to support art at Peterson 2,000
- Increased 8700 Misc/Contingency Expenses to 5,475 for needs that may arise.
- Decreased 7511 Book Fair Fundraising Expense to leave 2,000 for Art Department Funding
