 - 1. PAC Report (Parent Advisory Council)
 - 1. Had organizational meeting.
 - 1. Linda Gibson, Heather Earnhardt, Michelle Herro are Officers.
 - 2. Talked about how to support needs of parents during remote learning.
 - 3. Looking into purchasing blue light blocking glasses.
 - 2. Principal's Report with Budget Update
 - 1. Finances
 - 1. Non-Payroll Funds Everything is still in good shape
 - 2. Pointer Lines
 - 1. Had to clear negatives at the beginning of the year.
 - 1. Educators got their ESL endorsement and funds had to be transferred to cover their raises.
 - 3. 10th Day Enrollment
 - 1. K-3 down from 407 to 393 from 10th day last school year.
 - 2. 4-8 up from 458 to 463.
 - 3. 858 compared to 867 last year.
 - 4. CPS is not pulling funding at this moment.
 - 5. Unsure about next year and whether they will honor the 20th day enrollment.

4. Budget Transfers

- 1. Peterson was given \$20,000 as a stipend for mentor teachers. \$5,000 for 4 resident teachers but we received 5 resident teachers. CPS is paying for the extra mentor teacher.
 - 1. We were waiting for direction as to where to move the \$20,000 and now we know which bucket to move it into.

5. STEAM Updates

- 1. Changes are happening but it's slow.
- 2. All rooms need to be repainted.
- 3. Dance room needs mirrors replaced due to rust.
- 4. Furniture has arrived. A lot of cabinetry with wheels and balance stools to make the dance room have seating when needed.

6. Field Updates

- 1. \$626,000 for field and related improvements.
 - 1. Yalil reached out for a quote for the blacktop.
 - 2. Was told to pay \$7,000 to remove the boulders from the field and she is contesting Peterson having to pay that.
 - 3. Field of Dreams Funds
 - 1. Gym Floor, walls, sound panels.
 - 1. Sound panels so children can hear correctly and to save hearing for teachers.
 - 2. Floor was last finished in 2003.
 - 2. Getting risers with backrests for music department.
 - 3. Electrical and security camera updates.
 - 4. Currently coming up with a process to opening up the field.
 - 1. Have asked for community involvement. Field reopening sessions.
 - 2. Engaged the students in reflection on what they think can be done.
 - 3. Signs are being added at the Christiana and Kimball entrance.
